

# “Through the Bible: Exodus 24-31”

## I. Moses Speaks to the People; Plans for Tabernacle (Exo. 24-25)

- A. Twice, upon hearing God’s commands, the people made what announcement (Exo. 24:3,7)? \_\_\_\_\_
